Dear Disciples of the Good Shepherd ~

Imagine hiding in fear of your life and wondering what life will be like when you are able to come out into the open again. I know it seems that we are locked up, but it is a decision we make to protect ourselves and others from sickness and death. The early followers of the WAY must have had a similar experience with the exception of sickness, but some would face persecution and possibly execution. Having accepted Christ and becoming followers of the 'new' faith, life as an early Christian changed their whole world. Likewise, our whole world is changing even as we read this pastoral letter.

How do we gather knowing that we are safe and can trust others to be practicing social distancing? What guarantee do we have that the environment where we are meeting has been satisfactorily sanitized? How do we alter long-standing traditions in light of what we know about the Coronavirus? Passing the offering plate is out of the question along with singing. Blessings and Children's Time will be removed from the service for the foreseeable future. Congregating in the Narthex before or after services is a 'no no' along with greeting one another in the customary manner of shaking hands or hugging.

The question is, what would you want someone to do for you? The Golden Rule ~ do unto others as you would have them do unto you. This is not a selfish model, but a giving model. You and I are giving others the assurance that we would not put them in harm's way and give someone a potentially fatal illness.

As we continue to be patient let us pray for those in need (including ourselves) for God's intervention and protective shelter... for those combatting this pandemic...

If you signed up to receive flowers or bulletins during our paused worship services you need not pay, as flowers are unavailable. We will still include your request in the newsletters.


