Parsonage is a somewhat old-fashioned term for the housing a church provides to its clergy. Parsonage literally means "house for a parson" and a parson is the member of the clergy. The term is used more in British Anglican circles and is some instances with Lutherans. An older more informal word would be vicarage. In relation to the term parsonage, the word rectory in the same manner is a house for the rector, another name for clergy and in some cases for academics. The Scottish use the term manse which stems from the root for mansion.

All these terms refer to the place where a pastor lives and yet, I prefer to simply call this place home. And as is true for all of us, our home is a sacred and safe place. Somewhere to get away from the trials and tribulations of work and commerce. It's a place to and find peace, love, joy, along with rest for the weary soul.

If you had signed up to receive flowers or a bulletin during our pause on worship services you need not pay, as flowers are unavailable. We continue to include your request in the newsletters.


