






## Financial Peace University 2021

The food bank needs **CLERICAL** volunteers. NO LIFTING OR STANDING REQUIRED. The hours that need to be covered are: 2nd and 4th Monday of the month (1pm-3pm) 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursdays of the month (4pm-6pm) Last Saturday of the month (9am-noon) **Tuesday mornings** These hours can be divided among several volunteers. We will be happy with any amount of time you can give. The food bank is in desperate need of **PEOPLE TO LIFT** supplies, stock shelves, organize food that comes off trucks or supplied by outside vendors, stock refrigerators and freezers, light housekeeping (sweeping floors, etc.) and other warehouse duties. Any hours that you can help with warehousing on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday would be very helpful. Food Distribution Hours are as Follows: 2nd and 4th Monday of the month (1pm-3pm) 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursdays of the month (4pm-6pm) Last Saturday of the month (9am-noon) Please call the food bank and ask for Barbara Scheirer (610-767-9525) or speak to one of the warehouse volunteers.
