Dear Family and Friends of Good Shepherd United Church of Christ ~

KEEP MOVING FORWARD!!!

For some reason, change has been running through my life as an unbroken thread. It began with the sermon on the magi and the change they made on their way "home." And then there was the sermon centered on the Samaritans receiving the Holy Spirit ~ a Samaritan Pentecost of sorts. So, I've begun asking the question ~ what is God calling us to change about who we are in light of the still speaking God. Is God still working among the Samaritans? ~ is God still working among us?

I shared a quote from John Robinson (no relation) "the Lord hath more truth yet to break forth out of His Holy Word." He also goes on to reference some major players in the Reformation that made changes saying that Lutherans cannot be drawn to go beyond what Luther saw; whatever part of His will our God had revealed to Calvin, they will rather die than embrace it; and the Calvinists, you see, stick fast where they were left by that great man of God, who yet saw not all things."

I mentioned some people who have caused great change in our world so that we might be fairer and more just. People like Irena Sendler, a 29-year-old Polish social worker who offered frightened Jews food and shelter during the holocaust; Malala Yousafzai, a woman of Pakistan who, at 17, became the youngest person to receive the Nobel Peace Prize for her refusal to hide in fear but instead spoke of the rights that every girl has the opportunity receive and education; Lilly Ledbetter, who was the driving force to protect women in the workplace and receive equal pay as men; Rosa Parks, who wouldn't give up her seat on a bus and created a pivotal moment in the civil rights movement; Todd Beamer and the passengers of Flight 93, who fought back against the 9/11 terrorists and tried to take back control of the plane before crashing in a field in Shanksville, PA.

I know many of us have strong convictions around issues of faith such as children taking communion, welcoming all regardless of gender, orientation, skin color, economic success/failure, political difference, and other things that are yet to be revealed. I'm asking that you join us in these conversations with an open mind and an open heart. Let us try and see things from a different perspective, of one shutout or marginalized. And as we talk about these important matters for future generations, remember some of the people we are speaking about our right in our midst.






