Dear Family and Friends of Good Shepherd United Church of Christ ~

As the saying goes, April showers bring May flowers. A reminder to me that as spring unfolds with flowers blossoming there is a need for the right amount of rain and sunshine to nurture and warm seeds and bulbs buried within the earth. I think of seeds we've planted here at Good Shepherd and how the sunshine and rain have nurtured us through the joys we have experienced and hurdles we have overcome.

I shared recently a message about the need to reinvent ourselves ~ me as a pastor and those who worship as disciples. During this time, I encourage all of us to contemplate what gifts God has blessed each of us with and how we can come together to share these gifts with others on behalf of Christ. Over the past few years, we have made some major changes within the course of our journey. Aspects of these changes include what I refer to as Ministry Teams. These Teams are designed to focus on certain aspects of being the Church that lift up ministry which we are all called to. Perhaps one will speak to your heart and you will want to talk with the Team Coordinator or myself. These Teams include:

Communications Team, coordinated by Deb Craig, centers on social media such as our Website, YouTube Channel, Instagram and other more traditional forms of reaching the larger community like newspapers, radio, television, and posters.

Faith Formation Team, coordinated by Deb Craig and Pam Puskas, creates opportunities for children, youth, and adults to experience moments that form and strengthen their faith journey. Some feel called to teach a faith formation class or participate in VBS or lead special small group gatherings.

This offers those who wish to position their vehicles in the parking lot and participate in the service by listening to our FM Station 88.5.

Fellowship Team, coordinated by Dennis Silfies, include those individuals who like cooking, baking, and serving at funeral luncheons, congregational gatherings. If you would like to be contacted to bake goodies or prepare/serve meals, Dennis keeps a list of those who would like to participate in the ministry.

Mission Team, coordinated by Tammy White, lifts up and explores various missions that, we as a congregation, support and promote. A number of those on the Mission Team participate in such activities as delivering items to Christian Action Council of Palmerton Area Churches (CACPAC), creating meals for Veterans and Loved Ones Recovery (VALOR), stocking shelves at Northern Lehigh Food Bank (NLFB), or assist with special donations such as Backpack Buddies.

Resource Team, formerly coordinated by Bryan Horninger, would be a haven for those who like to work with numbers and data. People who enjoy working with Fundraisers, Hall Rentals, Memorials, and other means of congregational income offer suggestions to promote support for the ministry of Good Shepherd. Vitality Team, coordinated by Dennis Silfies, is active in planning for the future of our congregation focusing on both the physical plant as well as the unfolding mission as people of faith.

Worship Team, coordinated by Pastor James, is made up of a huge number of people who make the hour of worship (normally on Sunday mornings) possible through planning the service, singing in the choir, acting as an acolyte, volunteering as an usher or greeter, and those who clean and decorate the sanctuary for special occasions.

Youth Fellowship Team, coordinated by Mary Lacy, is not just for youth but also individuals who want to support the young in their modeling ministry from a younger perspective and looking to make a bigger impact on the future.

My earnest hope is that every disciple at Good Shepherd might volunteer for one of the Ministry Teams or several. This is an invitation to reinvent and renew our faith as we continue celebrating the past, serving in the present, and planting seeds for the future.

May we feel a surge of energy day by day as we discover ourselves as the people of God and followers of Christ.




