Mission Outreach for September is Allentown Rescue Mission

The **Allentown Rescue Mission** is a non-denominational, Christian, social services organizations, which provides critically-needed goods and services to homeless and impoverished men, without regard to race, color, creed, national origin or religion. The Mission is not a church, but does cooperate with many different churches that are concerned about poverty and homelessness.

The Mission continues to reinvent itself to address the increasingly complex root causes and issues of homelessness.

The **Emergency Shelter** provides the essentials to homeless men. They receive warm meals, hot showers, clean clothes and respite from the hardships of the streets.

The **Transformation Program** provides their guests with life and workforce skills and religious classes to help them reclaim their lives.

Clean Team Workforce members do a variety of jobs, earn wages, and save money as they transition back into the community.

Since 2007, DeSales University has offered **free medical services** to the clients of the Allentown Rescue Mission.


