

OUASIMODOGENITI

In the German Reformed tradition, each Sunday of Easter takes its name in Latin from the first few words of the introit prayer. The introit for the second Sunday of Easter is "As newborn babies desire the sincere milk of the WORD. Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee; O Israel, if thou wilt harken unto me." Quasi modo geniti loosely translated means 'as newborn babes.' This Sunday is known as Low Sunday.

Gathering for God's WORD

WELCOME

Welcome to Good Shepherd United Church of Christ, Slatington! It's the second Sunday of Easter, also known as *Low Sunday*, when things get a little chill and a lot more cheerful. Why "low"? Because the pressure's off, the joy is on, and even the early church theologian, Augustine, thought God pulled off the ultimate divine prank: raising Jesus from the dead, *Risus paschalis*, the Easter Laugh. So today, we celebrate with humor, gratitude, and maybe a few holy chuckles. After all, Jesus is the LIFE of the party!

* OPENING PRAYER

God of resurrection laughter, You raised Jesus from the grave, and in doing so, You turned mourning into dancing, fear into faith, and death into divine punchline. * CALL TO CONFESSION
